- Limited control over technology decisions

- Dependent on public internet connectivity

## Custom, dedicated environment for a single organization

- High security and compliance
- Complete control over resources and configurations
- Suitable for highly regulated industries

- Expensive
- Requires in-house tech staff or external
- Higher management and maintenance
